12. A vase of cut flowers
13. An unusual shaped vegetable
14. A creature made mostly from vegetables
15. A miniature garden on a plate
16. A flower arrangement in a cup and saucer
17. A jar of homemade Jam
18. A jar of homemade jelly
19. A homemade Victoria sponge cake
20. 4 Fruit Scones
21. 6 Jam tarts
22. An apple pie

Conditions of Entry

1. All entries must be your own work.
2. One entry only per class per person
3. Entries must be delivered to the Village Hall by 11.30am on the day of the show and be accompanied by a completed entry form which will be available on the day of the show.
4. Entry fees will be 20p per class except for entries by children under 16 who will be free.
5. Judging will take place between 12.00 and 2.00pm and judges' decisions will be final!
6. The Judges will be able to cut into or open entries in order to check consistency.
7. Certificates and prizes will be awarded at 3.00pm; entries may be collected between 3.30pm and 4.00pm. Any uncollected entries will be disposed of.

Granby & Sutton Garden Club meets the first Tuesday in the Month during the winter, either in the Marquis of Granby or the Village Hall. It also arranges garden visits during the summer.
